**Biographical:** After crossing the finish line at an estimated 105 MPH, he kept speeding in the shutdown area. He went off the end of the track into gravel, whereupon he slid broadside, flipped over three times in the air, and smashed into two trees. Track personnel rushed to free him from the vehicle.
